Celebrate teamwork, shared success, and individual strengths. Our focus is on learning and growing together—not winning or comparing.

Inclusivity & Equal Participation

Encourage every child's participation, regardless of skill level or experience. Value each voice and create space for all to contribute meaningfully.

Good Sportsmanship

Celebrate each other's wins, support one another in challenges, and always use kind and uplifting language.

Responsibility

Own your words and actions. Follow through on commitments, respect program guidelines, and contribute to a positive community experience.

Offer help, encouragement, and patience. Whether it's in an activity or a moment of conflict, show up with a spirit of support and care for the group.
